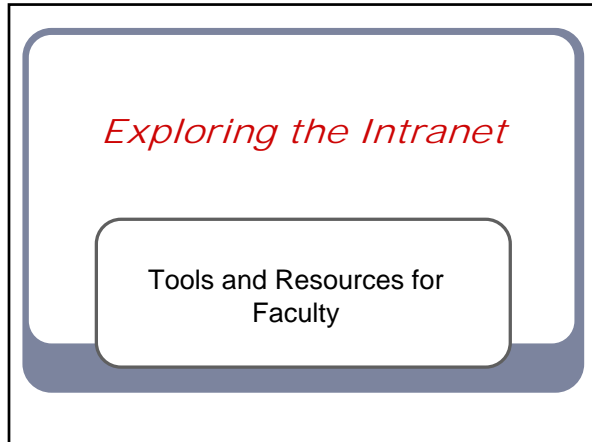

Intranet Defined

- internal web site used to facilitate communication and access to information
- access is restricted to members of organization
- SCCD Intranet was “born” Fall, 2004
- each employee group gets tailor-made information and tools

Why Have One?

- to provide better and easier access to information
 - Intranet VS Outlook Public Folders
- to limit access to information that should be “just for our eyes”
 - Payroll and Benefits
 - Instructor Briefcase
 - grant applications

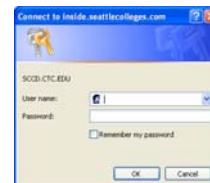
Accessing the Intranet

General Resources

- **Calendar**
 - academic calendar, board meetings, professional development
- **Telephone**
 - FAQs, voicemail etiquette, SCAN instructions
- **Payroll & Benefits**
 - earnings history, benefits, forms, etc.
- **Commuter Info**
 - parking, forms, area transportation updates
- **District Policies and Procedures**

Faculty Resources

- **Instruction**
 - IBC, enrollment reports, grant applications, part time faculty handbook, etc.
- **Web Space**
 - district faculty web server accounts
 - district department web server accounts

Faculty Resource - Instruction



Instruction Resources

- Instructor Briefcase for rosters and grading
- enrollment reports for current and past quarters
- grant applications
 - curriculum & online course development
- evaluation requests for distance and on-campus courses
- info on students with disabilities

The District Web Server utilizes Windows 2000 technology. Web Space on the server is available to faculty and to departments for college related sites.

Web Space Policy

- The default size for Web Space is 10 megabytes. Requests for larger spaces must be made to the webmaster, and are subject to review based on purpose of the site and the nature of the application used.
- Web Spaces with no activity (files updated) for four months will be deleted.
- Web Spaces are not for personal use or gain.
- Any planned use of script must be approved by the webmaster. All scripts will be tested on the district development server before they can be posted to the production server.

Faculty Sites

- Faculty sites are available for all full-time and active part-time faculty.
- An email account on the District Exchange Server is required.
- If you do not have an email account that ends in @sccd.edu, contact IT@S.CCD.
- The URL for faculty accounts will be http://www.sccd.edu/~your_email_address/
