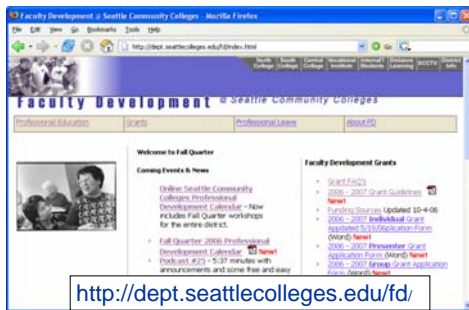

Faculty Development Web Site



Faculty Development Grants

- **\$53,000** available for grants
- for part time and full time faculty
- 3 types
 - **Individual** – up to \$400
 - **Presenter** – up to \$800
 - **Group** – up to \$1000 depending on audience

Fundable Grant Activities

- taking a class, attending a conference, workshop, etc. (individual)
- presenting at regional / national / international event (presenter)
- plus travel associated with above
- department training (group)
- district-wide workshop (group)

FD Grant Guidelines

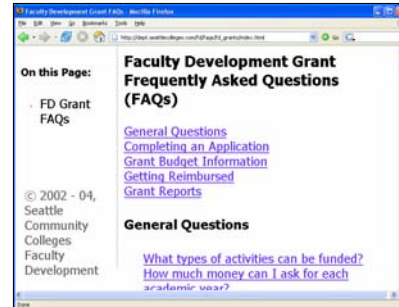
- **one** Individual grant per academic year (summer through spring)
- **either** a Presenter OR an Individual grant per academic year
- **one** Presenter grant **every other year**
- see copy of Guidelines provided in Packet

FD Grant FAQs

- must apply BEFORE activity
- original receipts (except for food) required for reimbursement
- deadlines for submitting short grant report and claim paperwork

FAQs on FD Web Site



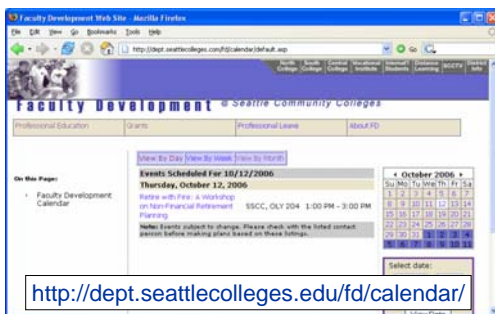
Other Funding Sources
